You Can Still Orienteer ...

- There is a **club training run** every Thursday with location details on the website. Please sign up in advance so we have all the details necessary to be COVID-compliant (https://docs.google.com/spreadsheets/d/1oPxe-uodfQJAD2yOJXAZg_tKVQKrkhmgx3kaQGVKU_I/edit?usp=sharing)
- ELO are running a local event at [Vogrie Country Park](#) on Saturday 28th November (note change of date from original Sunday 29th when it would have been the ESOC champs). Only for Tier-2 residents due to travel restrictions (so only for club members outside City of Edinburgh)
- [ESOC are running a Quadruple-H challenge](#) from 21st to 29th November, taking in Hillend, Harlaw, Hailes Quarry Park and also Hay Lodge Park in Peebles, using MapRun. The idea is to take part in as many as you can, travel restrictions permitting.
- Next **Fight With The Night (FWTN)** is on Thursday 3rd December in Corstorphine (City of Edinburgh residents only due to Tier-3 travel restrictions)
