Terrain	The Deans area of Livingston comprises typical Scottish housing schemes with many alleys and						
	cut-throughs, strips of urban woodland and, on the longer courses, more extended grassy sections. Expect 60% tarmac, 40% grass, dirt paths and runnable woods, steep in places and slippery when wet. Map is ISSOM2012. Woodland marked as white is super-fast. Light gree slower, but would be marked as white on normal maps and is sometimes the optimal route. Mid and dark green are not recommended for speed! The area is criss-crossed by roads with modest traffic: these are clearly marked with red striped overprint and, for safety and fairned considerations, they must not be crossed, even if clear of traffic. There are numerous						
	underpasses which must be used. All courses cross access roads and cul-de-sacs with speed						
	· ·	os and occasional vehicles. Majority of U12 course will be on paths away from roads but					
	with approx. 300m on low speed cul-de-sacs. Red lines are broken but not bent WHENEVER
