Junior Rep Job Description

1. Get to know junior members and keep in contact with them, so far as practicable.

6. Report club junior members success stories to the club committee, primarily for national and international level squads and events.
7. Encourage junior members to provide reports (short or long) for the club web site and newsletter.
8. Inform a club committee member and or your parents as soon as you see or become aware of any junior member injured, bullied, being troubled by a strange adult, etc.
