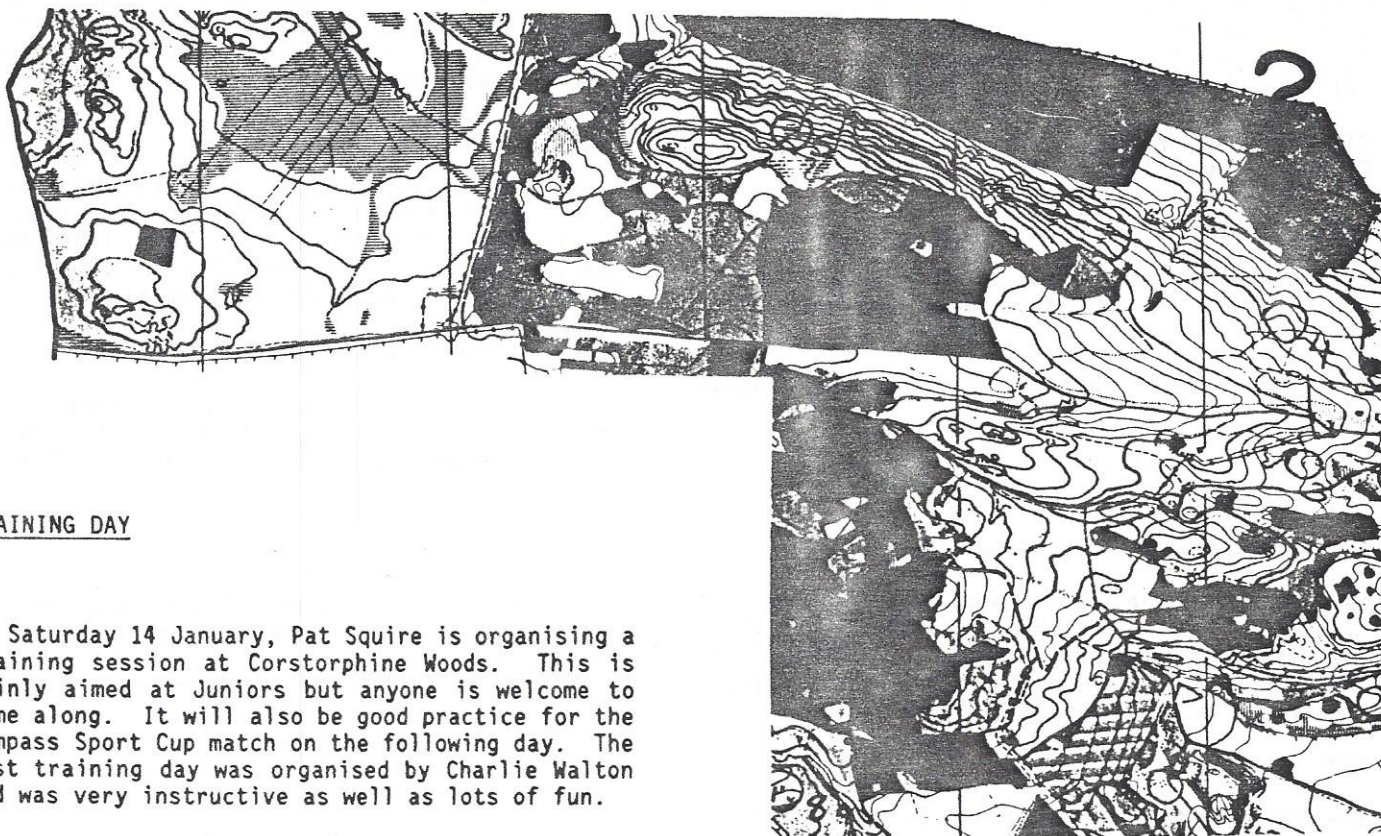

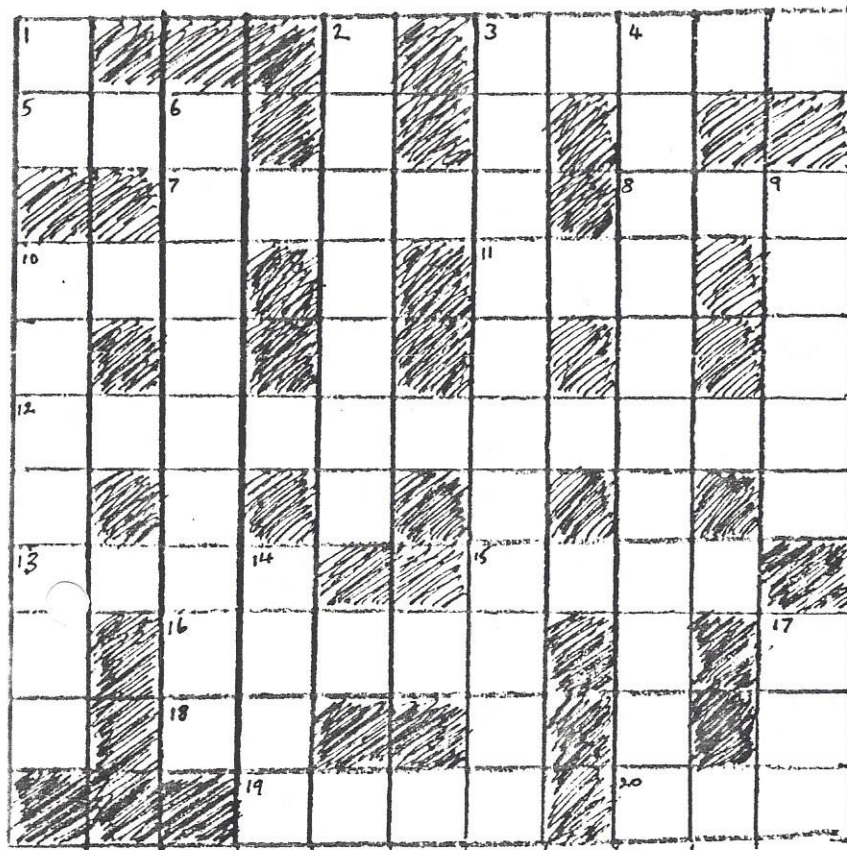
Good orienteering and a good holiday week for all! Entry forms are now out, the more Interlopers the merrier, so plan your summer now and fit in the 6-day.
